Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and Lord Jesus Christ. I come to you again to bring a word from chapter 15 of my book *Money Cometh to the Body of Christ*. The word is: **Jesus Christ is Lord Over Poverty and Lord of Prosperity**. He is the Lord Who can get you out of debt and cause you to live a life of abundance, peace and joy. I travel across the country and internationally preach this message from three platforms: *The Holy breath of the Bible*, *Holy Ghost inspired revelation*, and *personal experience*. I have walked through what I am teaching you. So, if God can catapult my life to prosperity, He can certainly cause you to live in prosperity.

Firstly, I want you to know that Jesus Christ went to the Cross, as our substitute, and shed His Blood so that we may experience this life abundantly (**John 10:10**). We were supposed to be on that Cross but, thank God, the Lord Jesus Christ took our place. **Galatians 3:13** says, **“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.”** Jesus hung on that tree so that we may not experience the curse. And I tell you that poverty—of mind, of relationships, and of finances—is a part of the curse!

Secondly, I want you to know that **God wants you to prosper in life and fulfill the desire of the Father**. Years ago God gave me the prophetic words **“Money Cometh to the Body of Christ”** to help usher the body of Christ from the hellish pit of debt so that it may fulfill God’s call. He told me that it is His desire for His people to prosper. He said that He wanted His people to prosper so that first, My Gospel may infiltrate the Earth, and secondly, My people can dominate in the Earth. You as a child of God must understand that one word from God—Rhema, Revelation—can change your life forever! This is why I constantly remind you as a partner that you should get to as many **Money Cometh to You Conferences** as possible, because God constantly breathes a **fresh word** in those meetings. They are fresh words that will change your life forever! This is how the Holy Ghost wants to do it, **THROUGH A FRESH WORD!** He wants to *freshly impart* His anointing from the meetings into your spirit.

Thirdly, I want you to know that **you are empowered to prosper**. Because you are in Christ, the Holy Spirit lives in you. And you wonder why you desire to live in prosperity. You wonder why something leaps in you when you see mansions and beautiful landscapes.... The Holy Spirit is just trying to get prosperity to tangibly manifest around you. This is why it is important that you constantly commune with God. Furthermore, because you are in Christ, you are Abraham's seed. Consequently, you are entitled to the blessings and promises that were given to him (**Galatians 3:29**). You will get to the point that when people bless you they will be blessed and when people try to curse you, they won't succeed in doing so (**Genesis 12:3**).

Fourthly, you must **set your mind to prosper**. Your mind has to be renewed toward prosperity before you can experience it. **Romans 12:2** says **"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."** You must renew your mind because your soul—your mind, will, and emotions—is not saved (**James 1:21**). Your soul still wants to think the same way it did before you were saved. Furthermore, your soul and senses—the physical man—can gather against your spirit if your mind is not renewed. The old paradigm thinking of your mind—I'll never experience prosperity, God wants me poor so that I will stay close to Him, or prosperity teaching is sacrilegious—will cause you not to enter into prosperity. You must leave some of your relatives and friends in the old paradigm. You can't afford to dwell there because future generations of your family are dependent upon your decision to live a prosperous life. Read and meditate **Philippians 2:5**.

Fifthly, **we are rulers over circumstances**. Jesus was a master at ruling his circumstances. In **Mark 4:39**, Jesus arose and rebuked the wind and the sea by just simply saying "Peace, be still" and the wind obeyed His voice. In Luke 5:4, Simon had been fishing all night long and couldn't catch anything, Jesus told him to "Launch out into the deep." After Simon obeyed Jesus, his net began to overflow with fish to the point that it broke. Jesus ruled that circumstance by turning lack into abundance.

What impossible circumstance are you facing today? What dream are you trying to fulfill for you and your family? What relationships are you trying to hold on to? I have news for you. You have the same Holy Ghost power in you that Jesus had in Him to rule over circumstance. If you would seek God in every situation and receive a rhema word from Him concerning that situation, you will dominate and become victorious.

As I conclude, remember that Jesus is Lord over prosperity therefore, prosperity is yours. **Revelations 5:12** says, **"...Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing."** In other words Jesus died to receive this sevenfold anointing of prosperity so that you may receive it. It is yours to have. The Holy Ghost has empowered you to get it, therefore, reach out in faith and take it. Glory to God! I want to say to the fathers have a happy and prosperous Father's Day. And don't forget that **2013 IS THE YEAR OF HUNGER, THIRST, AND BEING FILLED!**
